Food Security



594,812

Food Distribution

We distributed more than 594,812 pounds of food through our pantry, community meals, and by supplying smaller local food pantries.

139,719

Pounds of food distributed to 12 other food pantries – 139,719.



14,515

Pantry

In 2025, we served 14,515 households through the food pantry. This represents approximately 20,569 individuals of all ages.



17,269

Community Meals

17,269 people served through community meals at five sites.

Provided holiday food boxes to 903 families and 560 summer lunches to students.
